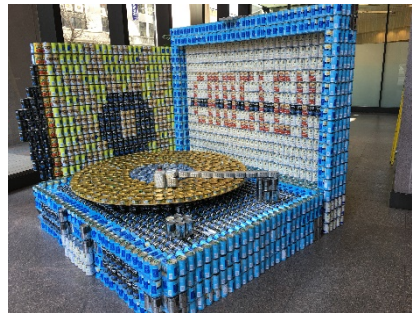




4th Annual Strut the Structures Tour

Cincinnati Canstruction® combines the fun of a design/build competition with an ingenious way to help feed hungry people. Local prominent architectural, engineering, planning, design and construction firms, and students mentored by these professionals, create phenomenal structures built entirely out of canned food. Judging occurs in categories such as Best Use of Labels, Structural Ingenuity, Best Meal, Most Cans and Best Original Design. Awards are presented at an annual fundraising gala. The public is also invited to cast their vote for their favorite in our People's Choice Award on Facebook. At the close of the exhibition all of the food used in these structures is donated to the Freestore Foodbank, for distribution to shelters, soup kitchens and other emergency feeding programs.
