Living Building Challenge “LEED on Steroids”

PRESENTED BY Greg Speidel, Senior PM, HGC Construction

Greg is no stranger to sustainable construction. Since joining HGC Construction in 2009, he has played an instrumental role in more than a dozen LEED certified projects and has worked to maintain the Cincinnati Zoo & Botanical Garden's reputation as the, “Greenest Zoo in America”. The **Living Building Challenge** is an international sustainable building certification program created in 2006 by the non-profit International Living Future Institute. It can be applied to development at all scales, from buildings – both new construction and renovation - to infrastructure, landscapes, neighborhoods and communities and is more rigorous than green certification schemes such as LEED. Certification is based on actual, rather than modeled or anticipated, performance. Therefore, projects must be operational for at least 12 consecutive months prior to evaluation.
